



COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Health and Safety Plan

hey dee ho educational services are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy workplace for all workers (including contractors and volunteers) as well as clients, visitors and members of the public. This policy is written in alignment with *National Quality Standard 2.1.2 - Effective illness and injury management and hygiene practices are promoted and implemented*

Keeping people safe

- hey dee ho educational services will run classes in line with our Covid-19 policy and Risk Assessment. We will continue to monitor the situation and update our guidelines as needed. Staff are informed of any updates to policies or training in writing via email and on our staff portal.
- All hey dee ho presenters have completed the Australian Government Department of Health Covid-19 Infection Control certified training as well as our internal comprehensive training modules on class procedures, personal hygiene and physical distancing.
- All staff will follow hygiene guidelines:
 - Staff will sanitise their hands before and after entering and exiting a service, and between each room
 - Staff will sanitise their bag/trolley and music player between each use
 - Staff will wear a freshly laundered uniform at each service

No presenter may attend work if :

- they are unwell, showing any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, sore throat, loss of sense of smell or shortness of breath.
- they have returned from interstate or overseas. Presenters are required to isolate for 14 days after arriving in their state.
- if they have been in close contact with a confirmed case of coronavirus in the last 14 days.

We recognise that each client may have their own Risk Policies and hey dee ho will stay in contact with services and undertake any additional measures as advised.

Class Procedures

- Introduction of new programming material about good hygiene and physical distancing measures

Props:

- All props are cleaned thoroughly prior to and after use
- No props or equipment are shared between children
- No props or equipment are shared between classes at early learning centres.

- Different instrument sets are used in each room at any one service or are sanitised between rooms.
- Different props or puppets are used in each room
- Yoga mats are not used where more than one class is being run in a service
- Props used by children who appear unwell, or have come in contact with saliva or respiratory fluid even if a child seems well, are isolated immediately
- All cleaning will be carried out in accordance with Government directions.

Physical distancing

- Presenters will observe physical distancing measures with educators and carers
- Presenters undertake to follow individual service’s protocols
- Presenters will avoid contact with others whenever possible (no high 5s or hugs - staying more than 1.5 metres from people).
- No merit stamps to be used
- Each of our programs are being modified to include activities which conform to physical distancing requirements
- Staff may wear a face shield when attending a service

Parent child classes

- Hand sanitiser will be available in the room
- Each participant will be required to complete a wellness check prior to each class
- Class numbers will be restricted in accordance with local state and territory guidance

Infection Response

If notified of a possible COVID-19 infection hey dee ho Educational Services will

- Isolate the staff member to prevent the spread of infection
- Seek advice from state and territory public health officials and follow local guidelines.
- Communicate with staff whilst continuing to meet privacy obligations
- If instructed by public health officials, tell close contacts they may have been exposed and follow advice on quarantine requirements
- Advise services
- Clean and disinfect any items, props or items in use by the staff member
- Review Risk Management Controls
